Open to all beef breeds

1. All entries must be owned and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
2. Limited to one entry per exhibitor per class, except that two entries will be allowed in three classes of the exhibitor's choice.
3. All cattle must be on grounds by 9:30a.m. and remain in stall until 3:30 p.m.
4. All pedigrees to be presented upon request.
5. All percentages eligible to show. Recordation papers must be available and must be purebred enough to be registered. Registration papers must accompany animal.
6. All cattle must be in good health according to Agriculture Canada Regulations.
7. EXHIBITOR NUMBER MUST BE DISPLAYED OR EXHIBITOR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
8. All exhibitors must carry personal liability insurance
9. All exhibitors must sign the HBBAS Liability Waiver

**Note:** A \$5.00 2017 Membership to the Hanover, Bentinck & Brant Agricultural Society will be required by each exhibitor.

**Class 1 ~ Junior Class:** to be shown by boy or girl 9 years of age or under as of Jan. 1, 2017.

4. Bull ~ Date of birth, 2015
5. Grand Champion Bull – Rosette  
Reserve Champion Bull – Rosette
6. Heifer born in 2017 (minimum of 3 months of age on day of showing).
7. Female ~ Date of birth, April 1st, 2016 to December 31st, 2016
8. Female ~ Date of birth, January 1st, 2016 to March 31st, 2016
9. Female ~ Date of birth, 2015 (with her 2017 purebred natural tattooed calf at foot).
10. Female ~ born prior to January 1st, 2014 (with her own 2017 natural, purebred tattooed calf at foot). Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Class 1.

11. Grand Champion Female – Rosette  
Reserve Champion Female – Rosette
12. Get of Sire ~ bred and owned by exhibitor. Both sexes to be represented. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.

13. Breeder's Herd (bred and owned by exhibitor). A group of four animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must be bred by the exhibitor, and at least one animal owned by exhibitor. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
