Ribbons given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup>

1. All entries to be in the hands of the Treasurer before showtime.
2. Exhibitors will not be permitted to make more than two entries in any class for single animal; not more than one entry in a group class. All animals must be eligible for registration.
3. Entry Fee: 15 percent of winnings deducted
4. Straw to be supplied by exhibitor and CLEANED UP BY EXHIBITOR.
5. If only one exhibitor in any class, first and third prize money will be paid only.
6. The judge's decision is final as to the placing of exhibits.
7. All sheep excluding long wool breeds not to have more than 1¼ inches of wool.
8. All sheep exhibited at the Fair must be accompanied by a Certificate of Health of the flock origin issued by a practicing veterinarian or a H. of A. veterinarian within 60 days of the Fair, and this certificate may be checked.
9. All exhibitors must carry personal liability insurance.
10. All exhibitors must sign the HBBAS Liability Waiver
11. All sheep must remain in stalls until 3:30 p.m. This will be enforced.
