- Applicants must provide proof of their volunteer service. The proof of volunteer service
 may be a stamped photocopy (i.e., a photocopy of the applicant's volunteer service
 record stamped by the secondary school from which they graduated or will be
 graduating)
- Proof of enrolment in a full-time agricultural, agri-business or environmental postsecondary program must be provided prior to scholarship/bursary funds being released
