Do you recognize a youth in the community, who has leadership skills, who is kind, respectful, willing to try new experiences, and wanting to know more about agriculture in our area, want to make an impact in their community and live in Hanover, Bentinck and Brant?

Age categories are the following:

Jr Ambassador ages 14-17 (as of Aug 1st)

Sr. Ambassador ages 18-21 (as of Dec 31st)

- Senior Ambassador is awarded a \$2000 scholarship towards post secondary education at the end of their reign
- Contestants must reside in the Town of Hanover, West Grey or Brockton (the former Bentinck and Brant Townships)
- Each contestant will be required to complete an interview, and prepare a 2-3 minute speech on one of the following topics: Urban Agriculture, Youth and their role in agriculture, Agriculture in Grey Bruce.
- All Contestants must be available to carry out their duties during the Hanover Fair. Ambassadors will also represent the Hanover, Bentinck and Brant Agricultural Society at various functions within the community throughout the year.
- Ambassadors have the opportunity to attend two district meetings of the OAAS (Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies), one in the fall and one in the spring.
- Senior Ambassadors also have the opportunity to attend the OAAS Convention in February in Toronto, and based on eligibility may compete in the CNE Ambassador Competition in August.

An ambassador is a youth leader for our Agricultural Society and community, representing at various local events throughout the year. The program assists youth with improving public speaking skills, engaging in new experiences, gaining valuable leadership experience and it all looks fantastic on a resume.

There are 2 different age groups for our ambassador program. Competitors can be male or female, thus allowing all young people the chance to experience this wonderful program.
